#### Model of Sacrifice:

Henri Hubert and Marcel Mauss (1964)

Consecration

Victim

Profane Sacred

Person

"The sacrificer remains protected: the gods take the victim instead of him.

The victim redeems him...

Because the victim is distinct from the sacrificer and the god, it separates them while uniting them: they draw close to each other, without giving themselves to each other entirely."



#### Christians as Atheists

"Hence we are called atheists. And we confess that we are atheists with reference to gods such as these, but not with reference to the most true God. First-century Jews who were expecting a messiah anticipated a person of power and grandeur, a great warrior-king who would overthrow Israel's political enemies...Jesus, on the other hand, was a relatively unknown teacher from a remote rural area who was executed for sedition against the state."


